- Respect your coach at all times remember they give up their time to help

- Always be on time for games
- Always wear appropriate footwear for training and games
- Make sure that you wear the correct uniform and tie up hair and cut nails before arriving at the game

Coaches Code of Behaviour

- Remember that children participate for pleasure and that winning is only part of the fun
- Never ridicule or yell at a child for a mistake
- Teach your players to follow the rules
- Develop player respect for their team, opponents and umpires.
- Remember to rotate beginner players to give them every opportunity to play all positions
- Ensure all players have equal game time throughout the season
- Whenever possible, group players to ensure that everyone has a reasonable chance of success
- All qualifying players must take the court in semi/prelim and grand finals
- Keep up to date on the latest coaching practises and principles

Parents Code of Behaviour

- Remember that children play sport for their enjoyment, not yours
- Encourage fair play and participation
- Focus on your child's effort and performance rather than winning or losing
- Never ridicule or yell at a child for making a mistake or losing a game
- Applaud good plays by all teams
- Ensure that your child arrives on time for games and is in correct uniform ready to play
- Respect officials at all times (there is to be NO communication between parents and game umpires)
- Do not approach coaches with complaints all parent complaints must be directed to the Club Secretary for attention and not to coaches
- Remember that children learn by example be a good sport
- ENJOY

Officials Code of Behaviour

- Compliment and encourage all participants
- Be consistent, objective and courteous when making decisions
- Condemn unsporting behaviour and promote respect for all
- Emphasise the spirit of the game rather than errors
- Be a good sport
- Remember you set an example. Your behaviour and comments should be positive and supportive
